Description how these independent learning hours were organized.</p> <p>Materials in English and Polish were provided and each person was instructed about the project and the workshop during individual telephone conversations.</p>





1.7	<p><i>Sumarization of Pre- and post-training self-assessment questionnaire results (foreseen: min. 80% of participants in the Train the Trainer workshop demonstrate improved knowledge, skills and competences in the subject of the training, measured by comparing the result of the pre- and post-training self-assessment questionnaires)</i></p> <p><i>Comparing the pre- and post-training self-assessment questionnaires results, all participants improved their competences and skills in relation to each module. The increase in knowledge and competences is significant in those who had little or no experience in social entrepreneurship and inclusive innovation. Those who had experience in social entrepreneurship also indicated an improvement in competence and knowledge but not to such a great extent. This also applies to all modules.</i></p>
