1.5	<p>Selection of academic staff procedures. Description how these staff was informed, selected...</p> <p>Throughout the project implementation process, Tetra team has maintained closeknit cooperation with the academic staff members at UNWE, involved in WP2 focus groups (interviews) and the development of a good practice on mainstreaming II&SE education at the HEI. There staff members were informed about the InnoSocial training through personal</p>



	contact. They spread information about the training to their colleagues within and outside the University. Five people mentioned above showed interest and enrolled in the training. The main criteria for involving academic staff in the training included: interest in the topic and relevant expertise.																																													
1.6	<p><i>Independent learning for preparation for workshops (13 hours). Description how these independent learning hours were organized.</i></p> <p>The participants were sent the InnoSocial Toolkit, Syllabus and Modules as a point of reference for self-learning. These resources were suggested mainly for reading, as a way of preparing for the virtual workshops. As another part of self-learning, the participants were asked to reflect on the practical assignments included in the course and suggest ways of implementing these assignments in a real-life teaching/learning environment.</p>																																													
1.7	<p><i>Summarization of Pre- and post-training self-assessment questionnaire results (foreseen: min. 80% of participants in the Train the Trainer workshop demonstrate improved knowledge, skills and competences in the subject of the training, measured by comparing the result of the pre- and post-training self-assessment questionnaires)</i></p> <p>According to the self-assessment results, all participants (100%) perceived improvement of knowledge and skills related to the modules covered by the training. 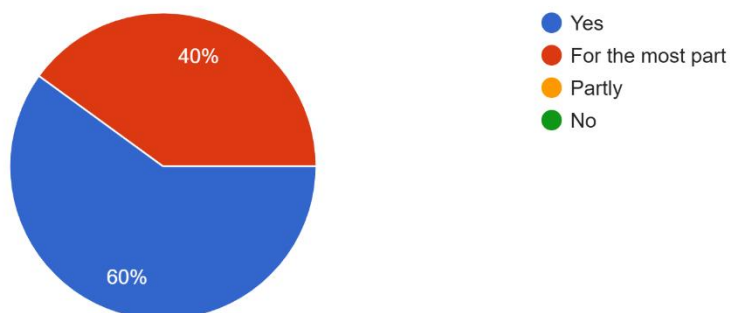

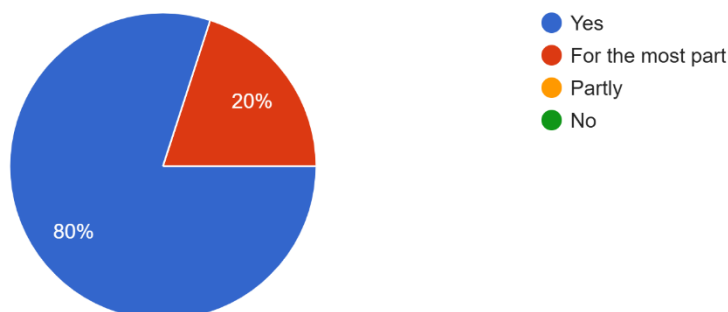

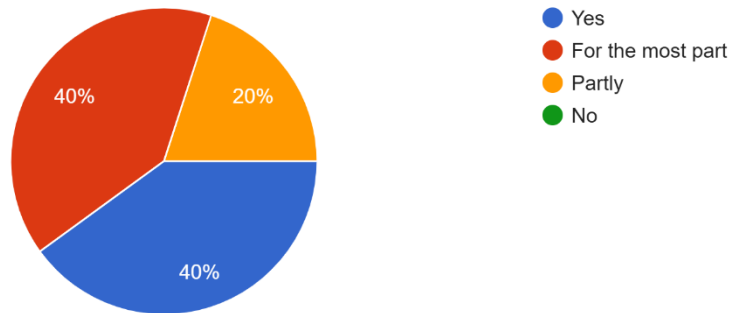

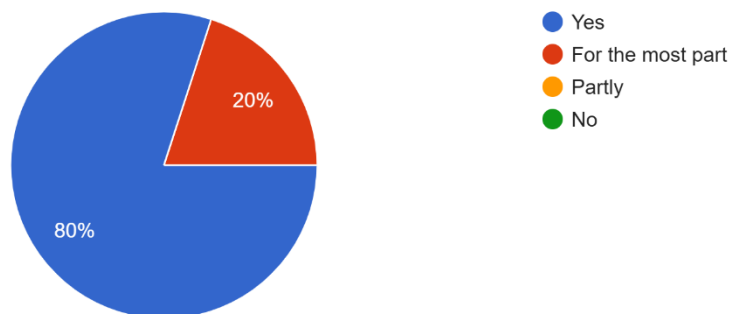

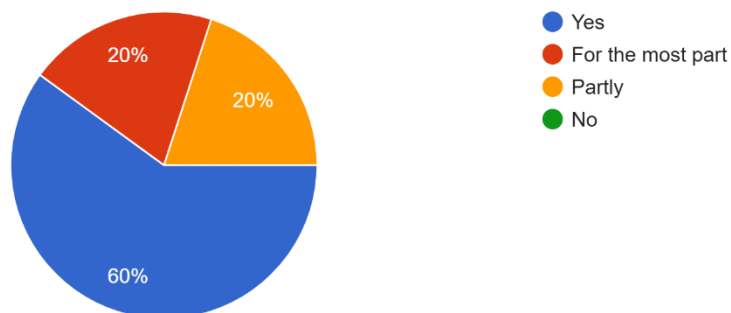
